Basketball/Volleyball - Busses/cars drop off students on Oak St. between Central Ave. and Encinal Ave.

Please escort your team past the tennis courts to the gym foyer. Physical Education classes will exit the gymnasium @ 2:45 P.M. You may enter with your team at this time. Locker rooms will be available @ 3:00 P.M. The gym preparation will be completed at approximately 3:15 P.M. After the gym is set up please have your team sit on the chairs closest to the main gym entrance. Bathrooms are located in the New Gym foyer. Please note that there is no public parking in our Oak St. lot until 5:00 PM.

Badminton - Busses/cars drop off students on Oak St. between Central Ave. and Encinal Ave.

Please escort your team past the tennis courts and our Main Gym to the Patton Gym. Physical Education classes will exit the gymnasium @ 2:45 P.M. You may enter with your team at this time. Locker rooms will be available in the Main Gym @ 3:00 P.M. The gym preparation will be completed at approximately 3:15 P.M. Bathrooms are located in the New Gym foyer. Please note that there is no public parking in our Oak St. lot until 5:00 PM.

<u>Football</u> - Busses/cars park on Clement St (cross street – Walnut St.). Please escort your team through the Clement St. gate (located directly behind our scoreboard) to the field and locker rooms.

Soccer – Estuary Park - 230-200 Mosley Ave, Alameda, CA 94501

Enter Alameda through Posey Tube; Turn Right on Willie Stargell Ave.; Turn Right on Mosley Ave. Field is on the Left

**Boys and Girls Tennis** - Busses/cars drop off students on Oak St. between Central Ave. and Encinal Ave.

Please escort your team to the tennis courts located directly off of Oak St. Physical Education classes may be using the courts and will exit by 2:45 P.M. You may enter with your team at this time. Bathrooms are located in the New Gym foyer.

Softball - Busses/cars drop off students on Oak St. between Central Ave. and Encinal Ave.

Please escort your team past the tennis courts and our Main Gym to our softball field. Physical Education classes may be using the field and will exit by 2:45 P.M. You may enter your dugout at this time. Bathrooms are located in the New Gym foyer.

<u>Baseball</u> - Lincoln Park - Fernside Blvd & Central Ave. Busses/cars drop off students on Fernside Blvd. Please escort your team to your dugout. Bathrooms are located behind the field.

- 2) Soccer games are ticketed events. Tickets are available for fans online at berkeleyhighatheltics.org or at the gate (\$5/\$3)

# DONAHUE and Freshman (wrestling) GYMNASIUM SPORTS (volleyball, basketball, wrestling)

Buses will drop off athletes at the white loading zones on Milvia (by Bancroft). The team will disembark, walk south on Milvia, and enter at the Athletic Plaza gates (between the softball field and the gym (where Durant hits Milvia). If the gate is locked, please text either AD Parker at 510-455-2332 or AD Vegt at 510-255-6025.

# **Important to note:**

- 1) School is out at 3:33 teams SHOULD NOT enter until after the final bell.
- 2) Only supervised teams may enter a gym space. Athletes that arrive prior to a coach must stay off campus.
- 3) The Donahue gym *does* have a team room for visiting teams to change and store personal items. The M gym (wrestling) does not.

# JACKET GYM and NATATORIUM SPORTS (badminton, water polo, swimming/diving)

Buses will drop off students at the gate on Milvia and Bancroft. The Athletic Director (or designee) will greet the bus and direct the team to the Jacket Gym (badminton) or pool (water polo and swimming). Unlike the other sports, badminton and aquatics athletes should enter at the gates at Milvia and Bancroft. If the gate is locked, please text either AD Parker at 510-455-2332 or AD Vegt at 510-255-6025. Important to note:

- 1) School is out at 3:33 4PM start time teams can be escorted into the pool before school is out. Badminton teams should stay off campus and let PE clear the gym.
- **a) Swimming/water polo:** The BHS coach will let teams in around 3:10 to begin warming up for a 4PM start **IF the visiting coach is present**
- 2) Only supervised teams may enter a gym/pool space. Athletes that arrive prior to a coach must stay off campus.

# Tennis - Heart Courts at CAL (2651 Bancroft Way, Berkeley, CA 94704)

Parking is very limited and not free. We have no free parking option as these are UCB's courts. There is 2-hour metered parking up and down Bancroft and side streets. Arrive with plenty of time to drop athletes, go park, and get warmed up for the game. We've found that after 5:30, no one really checks but before that we do see the meter folks patrolling the area. **Note:** there are bathrooms in the Hearst building but sometimes the building inexplicably closes early for the day. In that case, patrons will have to find a restaurant or cafe nearby. Sorry!

# Baseball - Tim Moellering Field (Derby St, Berkeley, CA 94704)

Limited but free street parking all around the field - arrive early to make sure you can secure a spot (note: many of the spaces are in foul ball zones). There are no bathrooms so fans/players must use the Sports Basement across the street.

#### Softball - Southeast corner of BHS

Supervisied teams may enter at the Athletic Plaza gate where Durant meets Milvia. *Normally*, the BHS coach is there by 3PM to let other teams in to warm-up.

**NOTE:** Please be quiet until 3:33 when school ends (no loud music)



#### **BISHOP O'DOWD**

When your bus (and/or team) arrives at, security will direct them to the appropriate place.

- **Football** will be directed to the field. One of our staff members will greet your team and escort them to the visiting locker room area (if available). For freshmen and junior varsity teams, the visiting team locker room area may not be available before the game if our physical education classes are still in session.
- **Volleyball** will be directed to the gym courtyard and/or lobby. Players can change in the gym lobby bathrooms. Please **keep players out of the gym** until our custodial staff has mopped and set-up bleachers.
- **Soccer** teams will be directed to the lower field. If classes are in session, please have your players sit in the bleachers until classes are over, usually around 2:50pm.
- **Basketball** teams will be directed to the gym lobby and remain there until escorted by our staff to the visiting team room, located down the stairs at the far end of the girls locker rooms. Please instruct your players to keep their bags with them at all times and not to leave anything in the visiting team room.
- Baseball will be directed to the visitor's dugout. If class is in session on the field, please make sure your coach talks to the teacher about warming-up. Visiting players should warm along the right field fence, throwing towards and away from the infield.
- Tennis (at Merritt College, Campus Drive) Please have your bus or cars drop players off at or near the tennis courts (located behind the Children's Center). Parking is available at any of the on-campus visitor parking areas or on the street (Campus Drive). If you park on-campus, parking permits will need to be purchased in the parking lot (\$2). Parking off-campus on Campus Drive is free.

## Badminton/Basketball/Volleyball Wrestling

Gate 6 will be the entrance gate. This gate can be accessed through the Redwood Road parking Lot or Mabel Street Parking Lot closest to Redwood Road. Once dropping off teams, Buses should find street parking. If unable to find street parking, we ask that buses park in front of the pool area. A team is able to enter campus with a coach. Campus Supervisors will direct teams, student-athletes and coaches, accordingly. Coaches should be supervising student-athletes at all times when on campus.

## Baseball/Softball/Tennis

Gate 1 will be the entrance gate. This gate can be accessed at the far North end of the Redwood Road Parking Lot. Once dropping off teams, Buses should find street parking. If unable to find street parking, we ask that buses park in front of the pool area. A team is able to enter campus with a coach. Campus Supervisors will direct teams, student-athletes and coaches, accordingly. Coaches should be supervising student-athletes at all times when on campus. Teams can stage on the visitor side of the bleachers. Restrooms are located behind the softball backstops.

#### Football, Soccer, Track

Gate 3 will be the entrance gate. This gate can be accessed through the Redwood Road Parking Lot. The bus can drop off the team under the Stadium scoreboard then proceed to park on Mabel Street. If street parking is unavailable, we ask that buses park in front of the pool. Campus Supervisors will direct teams, student-athletes and coaches, accordingly. Restrooms are located adjacent the Snack bar. Coaches should be supervising student-athletes at all times when on campus.

# Swimming and Water Polo

The pool is located in between Mabel Avenue and the Center for the Arts. If a bus will be dropping off the team, the bus can drop off students in front of the pool. We ask that street parking be found. Students can walk to the pool gate located on the north end of the pool complex facing the Center for the Arts Building. Coaches should be supervising student-athletes at all times when on campus.

#### **ENCIINAL**

Bus will drop off in the Third Street lot (behind school). Please direct bus to park at the south end of lot adjacent to the tennis courts.

**PARKING FOR FOOTBALL AT EHS -** Parking for the general public is available in the Staff and Student parking lots located on Central Avenue (in front of the school) and on the streets adjacent to the school. Drivers of vehicles which display a valid disability placard should enter the drive-in gate (located in the student parking lot) and may park in the designated area of the Quad blacktop.

Please note we do not allow parking in the Third Street lot during football games except for the players bus and cars displaying a parking pass. A maximum of 7 parking passes will be sent via U.S. mail to the visiting school's Athletic Director for distribution prior to game.

**PARKING FOR ALL OTHER SPORTING EVENTS AT EHS -** Parking for the general public is available in the Staff and Student parking lots located on Central Avenue (in front of the school) and on the streets adjacent to the school. For most non-football related events, coaches and the general public may also park in the Third Street lot. Bus will drop off in the Third Street lot (behind school). Please direct bus (or vans) to south end of lot adjacent to tennis courts.

**PARKING FOR CONTESTS AT EHS** - Parking for the general public is available in the Staff and Student parking lots located on Central Avenue (in front of the school) and on the streets adjacent to the school. On occasion, the Third Street lot may be available for general public parking (denoted by open Third Street gate). The Third Street lot is always available for vehicles displaying a disability

placard. Coaches may park in the Third Street lot during all contests, including football games.

PARKING FOR SOFTBALL GAMES (Washington Park: 740 Central Avenue, Alameda) - Parking for teams, coaches, and the general public is available on the street and in the parking lot.

**PARKING FOR CROSS COUNTRY MEETS (Crab Cove: 1252 McKay Avenue, Alameda) -** Parking for teams, coaches/the general public is available on the street and in the parking lot. Please note: the turn in for McKay Ave. is just north of Foster Freeze).

**WAITING FOR CONTESTS AT EHS -** For contests in the gym, all student-athletes should remain outside the school near the north doors (next to green transformer) until the Physical Education classes are dismissed at 3:05. Student-athletes and coaches MUST stay

together. In inclement weather, teams will be instructed where to sit in the gym until Physical Education classes are dismissed.

Football/Baseball/Tennis: If your team arrives before 3:05 you should sit on the football bleachers (south side of field). Student-athletes and coaches MUST stay together. Do not go on either field or the tennis courts until school is dismissed.

**LOCKER ROOMS:** - An Athletic Department representative will make sure that the locker room is secured and cleared before entrance is allowed. Football teams and Basketball teams will have access to the locker room. Staff will direct your team to the designated locker room for your contest. Teams should not leave any items such as bags or equipment in the locker room between games. Each team will have access during the half time period. At the conclusion of the contest, the locker room will be closed. Teams must be supervised at all times when they are in the locker rooms.

#### **ADMINISTRATORS:**

Game management personnel should check in with the Administrator in charge upon arrival to the contest. If the Administrator in charge cannot be located, the Gate personnel or Athletic Department representative will be notified. For both Football and Basketball games the visiting administrator should be present until the gym/field is cleared of all spectators, assist with crowd control, help keep all non-players off of the playing field or court, and help EHS administration with any issue involving student safety and in enforcing WAAC rules.

#### **SPIRIT SQUADS:**

Spirit squads are always welcome at Encinal High School. Spirit squad coach should check in with the EHS Spirit Squad Coach, or Athletic Director upon arrival.

#### **HAYWARD**

For **BASKETBALL**, **BADMINTON**, **VOLLEYBALL & WRESTLING** - When a visiting team arrives at Hayward High School they will arrive in the student parking lot if gates are closed please contact the AD. We would like them to stay together with their coach before leaving the parking lot. It is helpful if the coach can inform a P.E. teacher of their arrival. Please do not try to enter where the P.E. classes are located. The entrance to the gym is located up the stairs from the parking lot and down a ramp, where the Big "H" is located. Teams will be held in the cafeteria located just above the gym or if available in the gym. If schools can please inform us of arrival times we can make arrangements to accommodate them accordingly.

# For BASEBALL, FROSH FOOTBALL, CROSS COUNTRY, SOCCER, SOFTBALL, TENNIS & TRACK

When a visiting team arrives at Hayward High School they will arrive in the student parking lot if gates are closed please contact the AD. We would like them to stay together with their coach before leaving the parking lot. If P.E. classes are being conducted on the black top please walk around them to your particular field. When walking to the soccer and baseball fields please remain on the back side of our two story mods, do not walk in front of classrooms. Please keep all students off of the main campus. Locker rooms are available but please speak with a P.E. instructor first. JV Soccer Field is located on upper fields near baseball field, varsity games will be played on football field.

For **VARSITY & JV FOOTBALL at SUNSET FIELD**, corner of Western Blvd & Laurel Ave, Hayward, CA When arriving buses can drop off athletes on Laurel Ave near back gate of Football Field, If teams would like access to visitor's team it is located near the old Sunset High School gym on 567 Sunset Blvd. Buses can park on Laurel Ave or in gym parking lot.

PIEDMONT - The location for pick-up and drop-off for all buses at Piedmont High School is 800 Magnolia Avenue (at Bonita Avenue), in front of the high school.

Designated handicap parking is available on Magnolia Avenue and wheelchair access to the basketball gym can be found via the ramp in front of the middle school. Follow the ramp down to the middle school patio, past the middle school gym and around the district office to William 'Binks' Rawlings Gym. Designated handicap parking is also available at Witter Field in the small parking lot adjacent to the field.

In inclement weather, please check in with the high school's athletic office (down the main walkway and to the left) to be directed to either the Student Center or the lobby of the Alan Harvey Theater for gym events or to one of the locker rooms at Witter Field for field events.

Always, send an email to the athletic director about how many buses will be arriving and at what time.

Witter Football Field: Buses drop off/pick-up at 800 Magnolia Ave., in front of PHS. All players should walk through main walkway, and make a right. Walk down past William 'Binks' Rawlings gym, down the hill and stay to your left. Follow the stairs down to Witter Field. The visitor's locker room, if using the locker room (traveling football teams will use the women's locker room), is on the left. If PE classes are present, stay off of the field until 3:05pm. Do not drive buses down El Cerrito To Witter Field.

**Witter Baseball Field (Humphries Diamond):** Buses drop off/pick-up at 800 Magnolia Ave., in front of PHS. All players should walk through main walkway, and make a right. Walk down past William 'Binks' Rawlings gym, down the hill and stay to your left. Follow the stairs down to Witter Field. Make a right at Witter Field. Follow along the football field's fence, and walk down the stairs to the right to the visitor's dugout on the 3<sup>rd</sup> base side. If PE classes are present, stay off of the field until 3:05pm. Do not drive buses down El Cerrito To Witter Field.


Witter Softball Field: Buses drop off/pick-up at 800 Magnolia Ave., in front of PHS. All players should walk through main walkway, and make a right. Walk down past William 'Binks' Rawlings gym, down the hill and stay to your left. Follow the stairs down to Witter Field and make a left. If PE classes are present, stay off of the field until 3:05pm. Do not drive buses down El Cerrito To Witter Field.

**William 'Binks' Rawlings Gym:** Buses drop off/pick-up at 800 Magnolia Ave., in front of PHS. All players should walk through main walkway, and make a right. The gym is down the stairs and to the left. If PE classes are present in the gym, please wait outside of gym and gym lobby until 3:15pm.

**Piedmont Pool:** The Piedmont Community Pool is located at 777 Magnolia Avenue, across from Piedmont High School. Buses and cars should park on or near Magnolia Avenue. Permit only parking is enforced for specified and clearly marked parking spaces.

**Piedmont Tennis Courts:** The Piedmont City Tennis Courts are located on Vista Avenue Between Hillside and Bonita Avenues. Cars and buses should park on Vista Avenue or Magnolia Avenue. Permit only parking is enforced for specified and clearly marked parking spaces.

- The pick-up and drop-off spot for all buses at Piedmont High School is now at 800 Magnolia Ave. at Bonita, in front of the high school.

# DROP-OFF PROCEDURES (FOR GAMES AT SLHS)

## **SAN LORENZO**

All buses or cars entering the San Lorenzo west parking lot via traveling East on Lewelling Blvd. will need to drive past front of so and then turn into the Loop from left turn lane, proceed down front loop driveway to West parking lot. Loop area in front of school designated as a No Parking zone. Buses should have no trouble accessing parking lot this way.

**Soccer:** Enter from the West Gym parking lot. Have your team proceed directly to field.

**Basketball**: Enter Gym from West Gym Parking Lot. Please stay at the front of the gym and wait for gym to open. Please sit in bleachers and stay off of gym floor when entering. Staff will direct you to your locker room. Please supervise your team in locker rooms. Please remind teams to stay off gym floor until ready for warm ups.

**Baseball/Softball:** May enter the fields through the West Gym parking lot. Please have teams proceed directly to fields. Do not wander through the school.

**Tennis**: Park in the West Gym parking lot and have teams go directly to courts.

**Volleyball**: Please park in West Gym parking lot and then wait in front of gym until doors are open. When gym is open, please stay in the bleachers until court is ready for warm ups.

Football: Park in West Gym parking lot and then proceed directly to field.

We ask that all teams arrive with coaches and that the coach stays with their team at all times. Please monitor the locker room if you are using one. Also, please have your teams clean up after themselves. Do not allow students to walk the hallways. If a bathroom is needed, please find campus security or athletic director.

#### **TENNYSON**

**ARRIVAL:** Bus will drop off in the Student Parking Lot off of Whitman Street. (South lot.)

**PARKING:** Parking for the general public is available in the Student Parking Lot off of Whitman Street. (South lot.) Players and spectators should be cleared and off of school property within 15 minutes of contest end.

**LOCKER ROOM:** An Athletic Department representative will make sure that locker room is secured and cleared before entrance is allowed. Football teams and Basketball teams will have access to the locker room. Teams should not leave any items such as bags or equipment in the locker room between games. Each team will have access during the half time period. At the conclusion of the contest, the locker room will be closed. Teams must be supervised at all times when they are in the locker rooms.

<u>ADMINISTRATORS:</u> Game management personnel should check in with the Administrator in charge upon arrival to the contest. If the Administrator in charge can not be located, the Gate personnel or Athletic Department representative will be notified. For both Football and Basketball games the visiting administrator should be present in the gym until it is cleared of all spectators, assist with crowd control, assist with snack bar traffic, help keep all non-players off of the playing field or court, and help THS administration with any issue involving student safety and in enforcing HAAL rules.

SECURITY & SUPERVISION: For both Football and Basketball, Tennyson will have: 1 administrator, 2 teachers, 2 Campus Supervisors and 2 Hayward Police Officers on duty (if deemed necessary). For both Football and Basketball games the Campus Supervisors should be present in the gym until it is cleared of all spectators, assist with snack bar traffic, and help keep all non-players off of the playing field or court. Also, it is very important that all members of security have zero tolerance in enforcing the following: NO SUNFLOWER SEEDS, GUM, FOOD ITEMS OR SUGAR BASED DRINKS ON THE SIDELINES OF THE PLAYING FIELD.

**SPIRIT SQUADS:** Spirit squads are always welcome at Tennyson High School. Spirit squad coach should check in with the THS Spirit Squad Coach, or Athletic Director upon arrival. Spirit squad function is to create and maintain school spirit through good sportsmanlike behavior, courtesy, kindness and be a positive reflection of the school they represent.
