- 1. There was no public input and no changes to the March 28. 2023 AD minutes.
- 2. Representatives from the Bay Area Officials Association expressed their concern about the high number of changes to the volleyball schedules at some WACC school; made a general plea for more emphasis of sportsmanship, and expect their request to be honored for site supervisor accompaniment to their vehicles after games if necessary.
- 3. By Friday, 4/28, all league schools will have made the decision whether or not to play the presently-scheduled girls' basketball cross-league games, and if so, the site of that game. Girls' varsity basketball games will be scheduled for 6:30 pm with the JV game preceding unless a home school decides otherwise and communicates this decision to the league commissioner.
- 4, By Friday, 4/28, all league schools will have made the decision whether or not to play the presently-scheduled girls' soccer cross-league games. The league commissioner is working with Arroyo and San Lorenzo to reduces the number of single-game 3:30 starts.
- 5. WACC schools are pretty much caught up with rainout make-ups and AD's decided to continue the baseball and softball playoffs as planned.
- 6. Schools will make flag football decisions by our Friday, May 12 meeting
- 7. MSC (Molina, Duran, 12-0-0) to approve the following changes to the Football Special Rules"
 1313.1 The WACC website shall be used for nominations and balloting in odd-numbered years.
 The MVAL Commissioner shall determine the nomination procedure in even-numbered years.
 - Players shall be nominated by position. On offense those positions are **receivers**(4), linemen (5), quarterback (1), and running back (2). On defense those positions are linemen
 - (4), linebacker (3) (4), and defensive backs (4)
 - Coaches shall vote for 1st team and 2nd team honorees. A coach may not vote for his own players. If a tie occurs, and the tie can be resolved by determining which player received the most first team votes, it shall be done. Otherwise, ties shall be voted off; the coaches of the players in the tie shall not participate in the vote off. If two players remain tied at the end of the second vote, both all players in the tie shall be selected to the all-League team. If there is a tie for first team, the number of players selected for the second team shall be reduced. If there is a tie for second team, all players in the tie shall be given second team honors.
