Meet Rules and Guidelines

- No Coaches or Swimmers may enter the Pool Deck until instructed by the Championship Meet Directors (Tyler Tomei).
- Please refrain from setting up tents and chairs in non-designated areas. Parents and spectators can watch from around the pool deck and in bleacher areas.
- Parents and spectators are not allowed on the pool deck at any time. Only lifeguards, USA Swim Officials, certified coaches from teams in the meet, timers, trainers and student athletes are allowed on the pool deck.
- Teams are permitted to begin setting up around the pool deck in their designated areas up to one hour before warmups.
- No one may hang on or hop over the fencing around the pool deck. There are four gates at each corner of the pool that will be used for entrance to the pool deck.
- Please refrain from hanging on the lane lines.
- Parking is 3\$ for a whole day. If you do not pay for parking you will be ticketed.
- Teams are expected to clean up their designated area after each day of the meet. You MAY NOT leave any team tents, chairs, coolers etc. overnight. They will be thrown away.
- Teams are expected to bring one case of water for officials and meet volunteers. Teams will be assigned one lane and be responsible for providing 3 timers for their designated lane each day.
- All Chabot College, USA Official, NCS and League Rules apply for this meet.

- Award medals after the 50 meter free for the first 8 events, after the varsity 200 free relay (or during the non-varsity 200 free relay), and at the end of the meet.

- Man the main gate, admission fees, sell tix, get amount to the League Commissioner
